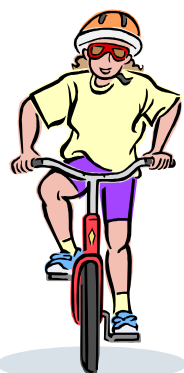
There is also an extra Bank Holiday for the Royal Wedding on Friday 29th April. School will be closed on this day.
