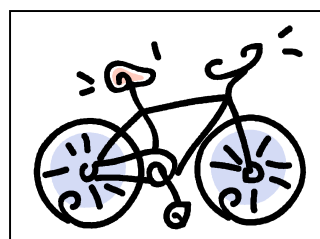
Staff News
