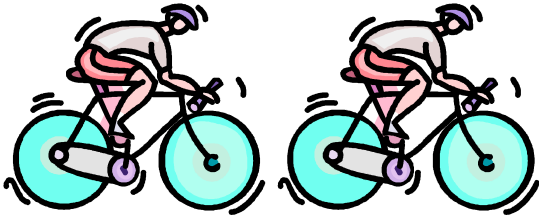
Pear Class *had a great time on Wednesday at Bridgwater Library - well done!*
